## Eligibility Requirements:

- 18 years of age or older
- Have a diagnosis of serious mental illness (SMI)
- Medicaid or Medicare Eligible

Have experienced at least ONE of the following:

- Long-Term <u>Hospitalization:</u> Three or more cumulative or consecutive years spent in an inpatient psychiatric hospital during the five years before the referral
- Jail Diversion: Four arrests and two psychiatric crises during the three years before the referral
- <u>ED Diversion</u>: 15 or more emergency room visits for any reason and two psychiatric crises during the three years before the referral
